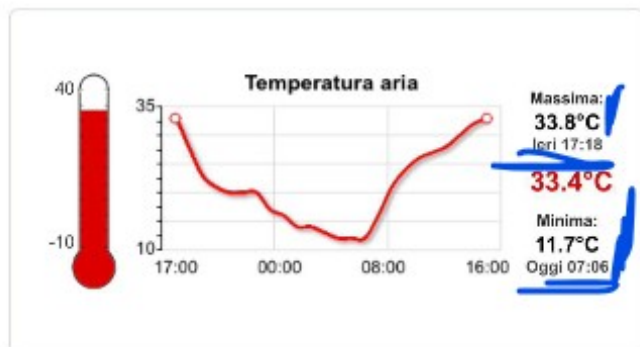
Youngest single vineyard planted in 2011.

One of the coolest zone of Montalcino with a ideal climate which allows the amazing evolution of aromas and incredible balance and finesse.

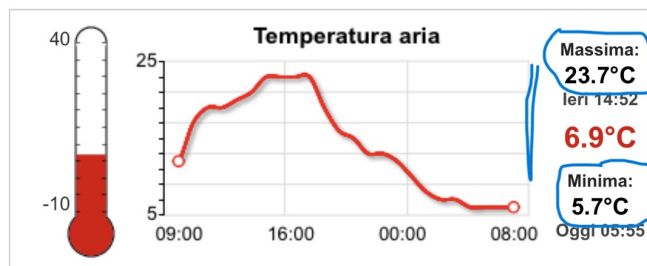

Winemaker's Notes: The Cortonesi Rosso di Montalcino “La Mannella” shows a fleshy and voluminous nose of cherries, underbrush and lavender. The palate is medium- to full-bodied with restrained richness and a charming, approachable character. Easygoing, fresh and succulent. Drink now!. This is a classic expression of the coolest zone of Montalcino with an open and food-friendly personality. There is a playful touch of sweet cherry on the close. Fruit is sourced from the La Mannella zone, one of the coolest growing areas in the appellation at around 300 meters above sea level. Winemaking is traditional, using 30-hectoliter Slavonian oak for one year and this reinforces all those fun fruity notes on display in the 50,000-bottle release.

The grapes for this wine come from the heart of Montalcino, on 19.768 acres of family-owned vines situated on a 984.2-foot hill on north side of the city (near the Montosoli Zone). The soil on the north side is rocky clay, with excellent exposure to the sun and large amount of stones. The vineyards training system is spurred cordon. After careful selection of the hand-picked grapes, fermentation takes place with maceration for 10-12 days in stainless steel vats at controlled temperatures between 78.8° F – 86° F (26° C – 30° C). The wine then spends 12 months in large Slavonian oak casks. The cooler zone of Montalcino give very classic Sangiovese wines with big finesse and beautiful balance.

Cortonesi makes a very satisfying Rosso that drinks and performs above its weight class. The 2021 Rosso di Montalcino La Mannella (with 20,000 bottles released) shows a dark garnet color with medium-lean concentration. There is plenty of dark cherry and fresh fruit at its core. That center is framed by earthy notes of iris root and chestnut husk. All of those flavors conclude with pretty freshness. Monica Larner
